Data Protection Statement (July 2019)

Connected Places Catapult (company number **11837978**) is the data controller in respect of the personal data that you give to us on this form (your “Personal Data”). We will use your Personal Data to:

- add you to our contact database (which may be hosted by our third party hosting provider) and, if you’ve agreed, we’ll record your research interests on our capability map;
- create a profile of you based on your research interests and the focus areas that you’ve indicated your research falls into;
- invite you to events that we think you would be interested in based on your research interests and focus areas;
- pass your Personal Data to the third parties that you’ve indicated that you’re interested in building relationships with, who may subsequently contact you; and
- if you agree (by using the tick boxes overleaf), to send you marketing e-mails about Connected Places Catapult, to send you invitations to events and/or to send you information about the products and services of third parties (including opportunities that we think may interest you based on your research interests and focus areas).

We send you marketing communications based on your consent. You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time – to do so, please click the ‘unsubscribe’ link in the relevant e-mail or contact us at academia@ts.catapult.org.uk.

Other than for marketing communications (described above), we use your Personal Data on the basis of our legitimate interests in helping to expand our, and your, network and to be able to keep in touch with you about upcoming events and opportunities that you may be interested in based on your research interests and focus areas.

All information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers, which are located within the European Economic Area (EEA). If at any time we transfer your Personal Data to, or store it in, countries located outside of the EEA (for example, if our hosting services provider changes) we will ensure that appropriate safeguards are in place for that transfer and storage as required by applicable law.

We’ll keep your Personal Data for as long as you’re subscribed to our database, and we’ll remove it when you ask us to do so. We’ll add your details to a “do not contact” list (which data protection law allows us to do) to ensure that you’re no longer contacted by us.

Under data protection law, you have rights in respect of your Personal Data. You have the right:

- to be informed about the processing of information (this is what this statement sets out to do);
- to have information corrected if it’s inaccurate and to have incomplete information completed;
- to object to processing;
- to restrict processing;
- to have your information erased;
- to request access to information about you and information about how we process it;
- to move, copy or transfer your information;
- rights relating to automated decision making, including profiling; and
- to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner’s Office where your data has or is being used in a way that you believe does not comply with data protection laws. We encourage you to contact us before making any complaint and we will seek to resolve any issues or concerns you may have.
