### Purpose of the Role

To support that implementation, CPC requires an API Developer, who will be responsible for designing and building integrations between the HR system, IT, and other systems.

### Key Responsibilities

- Analysis, design, development, and implementation of new and/or existing business applications and software. Development will largely consist of API integration work.
- Maintain and develop API integrations between internal and external IT systems
- Provide technical expertise when evaluating and designing solutions, ensuring all components and subsystems impacted are properly addressed during business application build and deployment.
- Act as a liaison to IT and Digital Innovation and businesses to improve both IT and business processes to enhance services where applicable.
- Create test cases and assist in technical and end-user testing. May help deploy solutions to IT and Digital Innovation teams outside of the HRIS team.

### Required Skills and Experience

- Experience with web service integrations (primarily REST and SOAP).
- Utilize the O365 / Azure / Active Directory and Power Automate ecosystems to automate provisioning and tasks
- Good understanding of information systems and business processes
- Ability to work effectively with business users to ensure technical solution meets business requirements

- Ability to work in a collaborative team environment, with the ability to communicate and coordinate effectively with other areas of the business
- Team player that is comfortable working in a highly agile environment.
- Proven capability to manage competing priorities within short timelines with little to no supervision
