Yourpersonal inform ation collected will be used to allow us to deliver services on behalf of Highways England and assess whether your application meets the criteria and scope of the program me. The program me operates on an open and transparent basis, your application will be assessed against the assessment criteria, detailed in the Application Guidance document for this Program me. Your IP address will be used to allow Connected Places Catapult to set appropriate access permissions on the website.

Access to and use of inform ation concerning yourself and your company is strictly controlled to ensure compliance with applicable data protection law. In many cases we pseudonymise or anonymise your inform ation before we share it with others, or when we no biger require the information in identifiable form. Anonymisation is the process of turning data into a form which does not identify individuals and where identification is not likely to take place. Pseudonymisation is the processing of information in such a way that it can no biger be attributed to you without the use of additional information and where that additional information is kept separately. This allows for a much with ruse of the information for statistical or other purposes.

How bng dowe keep your personal inform ation for?

W e retain inform ation in accordance with our legalobligations and national best practice. We ensure com pliance through regular auditing and ensure inform ation is securely disposed of when it has reached the end of its retention period. We im plem ent data retention periods for different categories of personal data and/or different processing purposes, including where appropriate, archiving periods. We will only keep your personal inform ation for as bong as reasonably necessary to support service users, to support our legitim ate business interests and to com ply with our legal and regulatory requirem ents.

International transfers of your personal information

Connected Places Catapult takes part in global projects. We (or third parties acting on our behalf) may store or process inform ation that we collect about you in countries outside the UK.
